At this time there are no reference standards available for (+)-d8-THC. (+)-d8-THC is a different compound from the main (-)-d8-THC cannabinoid and, therefore, these two compounds may have different efficacies. Using the most advanced instruments and techniques available, the separation of (+)-d8-THC and d9-THC is problematic for the scientific community as a whole. PharmLabs believes the unidentified peak to be a combination of (+)-d8-THC and d9-THC with the majority, if not all, of the concentration being (+)-d8-THC. Total (+/-) D8 Concentration is estimated to be: 81.13%
